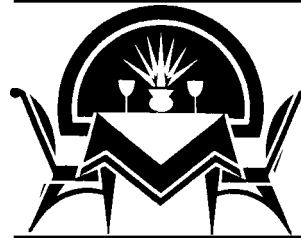

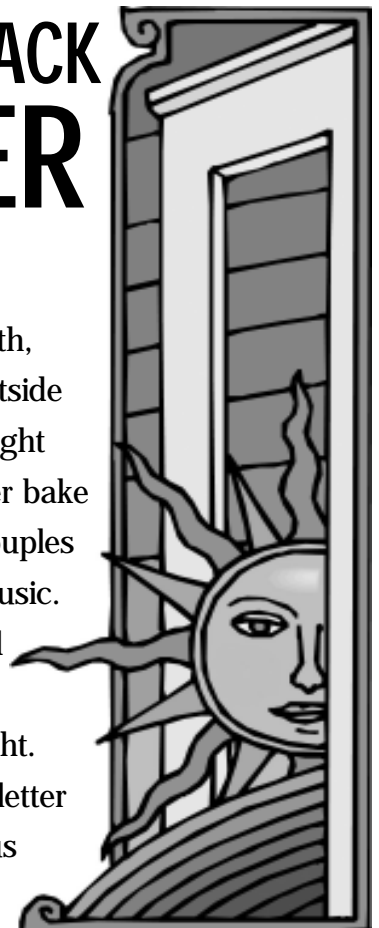

welcome back

2007 promises to be an exciting year. The pro shop will open as soon as the weather permits. Steve returns for year #18, assistant pros Joe Alonge and Adam Singer both are coming back to service your needs. Remember that we are the only private club that always has carts on at least nine holes.

tee times will not be required in april

Weekend tee times are enforced as per the Rules and Regulations in your Chip Shots. The pro shop will open at 12:00 on Mondays, 8:00 on Tuesdays-Fridays and at 7:00 on Saturdays & Sundays.

practice range opens weather permitting

The practice range will be open as soon as the ground is firm enough so the range balls will not plug. As a rule of thumb, the range will be open except when the soil is too wet. Usually, when carts are not allowed on the front nine, the range will be closed.

The range will close two hours before sunset on Sunday, Tuesday, and Thursday. The following mornings are designated as mow days and the range must be picked clean on these nights.

club storage

Club storage is available to all members. The pro shop staff will store and clean your clubs after every round. The fee is \$85 (80.19 + 4.81 tax) to have clean clubs for the entire season. Why lug those heavy clubs around when you can let the staff do it for you? The fee may be paid in the pro shop or billed through your Country Club account. Storage also includes minor repairs, free use of a pull cart, and a set of name labels for your clubs.

half-price mondays

During April & May, guests green fees are \$27.50 on any Monday that an outing is not scheduled. The pro shop opens at 12:00.

april is free fitting and trade-up month

Sponsored by the PGA of America, get a free club fitting from Steve and register for a free set of clubs with the PGA. More details in the pro shop.

posting scores begins april 15

The first official day of the golf season as recognized by the Erie District Golf Association is April 15. All rounds played after that date must be adjusted and entered in the computer. Rounds played in southern and western areas that were considered in season at the time of your round should be posted in the order they were played. You will need the date, course rating and the slope from each club. You can also post over the Internet by going to www.GHIN.com. You will need your GHIN number. Posting Computers are available in the pro shop, and both the men's' and ladies' locker rooms. Handicap cards can now be printed at the touch of a button. By using the pro shop terminal only, you will see a button named "Handicap Card". Press it and your card automatically prints. We will again be on the GHIN System offered through the Western Pennsylvania Golf Association. Under the GHIN System, you can post a score at an away course at the club you play if they are in the GHIN System. You will need your GHIN number.

All scores must be adjusted before posting as per USGA Regulations. The pro shop staff will be glad to assist you with any questions.

When posting your scores, be sure to post for the proper tees.

crane's tip

Be sure to do some stretching exercises before taking big driver swings. Loosen up your back, shoulders, arms, and legs. After stretching, start with some short and mid length wedges. Work your way through your irons with a 7 iron and maybe a rescue club before trying the woods.

Most of us start out the year with a nice easy swing. Its amazing how well you play when you have good tempo and a nice relaxed swing. Remember this as the season progresses. Tempo and balance are two of the most important factors to a good golf swing.

etiquette tip

Ball marks always seem to be a problem. Players need to be especially aware in the spring and fall when conditions are soft and even the shortest shot can leave a ball mark on the green. Please do your part to repair your ball marks and one or two others you may see. If all players accept this responsibility, we can solve this problem. To properly repair a ball mark, start on the outside of the mark and work the grass up. A properly repaired ball mark will have no dirt showing. handicap tip

Numerous away scores can change a player's handicap index drastically. If a player's USGA Handicap Index increases by three or more strokes due to the posting of away scores, and subsequent scores at his club clearly indicate that his index is too high, the Handicap Committee shall adjust his USGA Handicap Index downward.

men's tuesday night league

The league is open to all members. 9 holes are played on Tuesdays starting at 4:00 until 5:45. Teams consist of five members. All members are invited to play. If you have a team or would like to join the league and be placed on a team, call Steve before the Captain's meeting. League play begins with a get acquainted night on April 24. Matches begin May 1.

RULES QUESTION

At the Bay Hill Tournament on #18, Sergio's ball landed across the water hazard but bounced back in. Why was he allowed to drop his ball on the green side of the water?

ANSWER: The water hazard is marked with red stakes so it is a lateral water hazard. One of the options on a lateral water

hazard is that you may drop a ball within two club lengths of point of entry no closer to the hole. Had the hazard been marked with yellow stakes, this option would not have been available to him. Sergio would have had to gone back to the other side of the water, keeping the point of entry between the spot where he drops the ball and the flagstick.

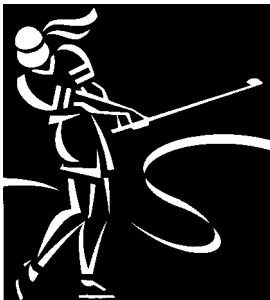

- The candidate should be **familiar with the general organization** of the club and understand that club operations need to be run by a professional manager and not by an officer or the board.
- The candidate should be a **consistent user of club facilities and services**, a participant in club functions and activities. The infrequent user does not have a “feel” for club operations.
- The candidate should have the ability to “**do his homework**” when a problem arises and not jump to conclusions.
- The candidate should have the **right “personality”** for the board. Can he or she disagree on a major issue without being disagreeable?
- The candidate should **not be stubborn in his or her thinking**. He or she should be willing to give the system in place a chance to work before calling for extensive reforms.
- The candidate should be **willing to devote time** to a project and have a reputation for attending meetings regularly.
