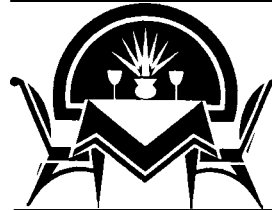

crane's tip

Unsure which way a putt is going to break? Let your feet do the talking. As you address the ball you feel in your feet what is uphill and downhill. Use to help determine the amount of break.

RULES QUESTION

You have placed your ball on the putting green. You take your stance and ground your club. You have not touched your ball but it moves. Is there a penalty? Should you play the ball as it lies or replace it.

ANSWER: Rule 18-2B states: If a player's ball moves after he has addressed it, the player is deemed to have moved the ball and incurs a penalty stroke. The ball must be replaced.
