## message from the president

The "Debt Reduction Plan" was presented to the membership and for those attending was accepted very well. I will not review the plan but rather tell you why

I believe the plan is right for Lake View Country Club. For those of you that were not able to attend, you may request a copy of the presentation and we will be happy to mail it to you. We will be including with next month's bill a straw vote ballot to be filled out by those who were unable to attend.

As was pointed out very well by the committee, we cannot support the debt we have with our current membership numbers. The plan will completely eliminate our financial burden and let us keep dues at current levels and reserve for capital improvements, something we are not able to do right now. Our club would look much better to a perspective member if they knew our finances were secure and there were no more of those bad rumors about our future.

For the individual member it's a very sound investment. The committee has created spreadsheets that will be posted in the locker rooms that will show you that over time the investment return will be significantly higher than 5%. Remember that you will have a very salable asset that will only appreciate in value over time. For someone who does not currently have the money to invest, the committee has charts that show you can actually borrow the money from a bank and have a lower payment than the current dues structure and if borrowed against your home, have the ability to deduct the interest and save even more money. The idea of not paying dues for the rest of your playing days and then selling the membership to someone who would get the same privileges seems very attractive to me.

The committee did a wonderful job in creating and presenting a plan that works for both the club and the member. The easy way is to say "let someone else make the investment" and continue to play the best course in town and not have the worry of future dues increases and assessments but remember the plan only works if we get fifty members to participate. I think it a great investment and I plan to be one of the fifty. Please consider joining me in guaranteeing Lake View Country Club's future.

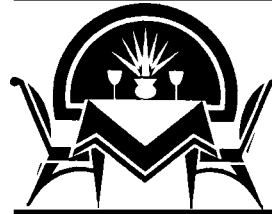

### CRANE'S TIP

Your ball will break more than you think on downhill putts and less on uphill putts. Because you hit the ball harder on uphill putts you will putt "through" the break. The ball will not turn until the end of your putt. Downhill putts are just the opposite. Because the ball is rolling slower, it will take the slope more. Plan on more break.

## **RULES** ————— **QUESTION**

Your ball is on a cart path, what are your options?

**ANSWER:** The cart path is considered an immovable obstruction. You are entitled to relief for interference of swing and/or stance. Option #1: play the ball as it lies. Option #2: find the nearest point of relief, no closer to the hole that provides full relief for swing and stance. From this point you must drop the ball within one club length.
