# In Memoriam

With the recent observances of Memorial Day, we wish to acknowledge the recent passing of three prominent members of Lake View Country Club.

Ruth Cochran was a Lake View member for 40 years prior to her passing on April 14, 2006. She served on the LVCC Board of Directors and various leadership positions in the women's Tuesday and Thursday leagues. She also was a very active participant in many club events with her companion and good friend, Charlie Stewart.

Edward "Ted" Selkregg, formerly of North East, passed away in June, 2007, in Prescott, Arizona. "Ted" was one of the founders of Lake View and one of the original "rockpickers" whose names are enshrined on the Memorial Boulder outside the LVCC clubhouse. He was a charter member and also served on the Board of Directors.

Jim Mahoney Sr., teacher, coach, and one of LVCC's most avid golfers, died May 14, 2007, at the age of 82. You always knew if Jim was playing in front of you, since he always marked his ball on the green with the ashes from his signature cigar. Fittingly, Jim was buried in his Lake View golf shirt, attesting to his love of the game and the club. He is survived by his wife Theresa and six children, including Dr. Jim Mahoney, one of the club's better players.

All three played an active role in the development of our club and are sadly missed by their friends and golf partners at Lake View.



## RULES QUESTION

- #1) – In match play, do you have the option to putt out?  
#2) – In match play, you want to mark your ball and your opponent, who is off the green, wants you to leave it there. What are your options?

**ANSWER:** #1 – You do not have the option of putting out in match play. The player that is farthest away from the hole has the honor. If you play out of turn in match play, your opponent has the option to cancel your stroke and require you to play the stroke again.

#2 – You are in control of your own ball, you may mark it if you so desire.

## message from the president

All the pros look forward to our event because of the condition of the golf course and the dinner afterward. This year was no exception. The board would like to thank Dr. John Damcott, who has chaired the event for the past four years, for his dedication and service. The low pro this year was our own Adam Singer. He is the first assistant to win this tournament since 1985. Congratulations, Adam.

At the annual meeting we had discussion about our smoking policy as it pertains to the grill room when an outside event is in the dining room. The Board of Directors considered our options and decided to change the policy. The new policy states that whenever the dining room is booked for an outside event the grill room will be non-smoking. This will give the non-smoker the ability to eat at the club in a smoke free environment. On those evenings the card room will be the only area designated for smoking. The board believes this is a good compromise and gives all our membership an area to enjoy the club in an atmosphere of their liking. Another change is the location of the scoreboard. When the scoreboard was moved to the old range it was only to be temporary and most believed it was not the ideal location. We have now located it just off the deck in a spot that will be visible from 18 green, the putting green, clubhouse patio and the deck. It will be out of the way but in a central location that just may encourage more use of the deck area during club events. This board continues to try to improve our club and encourages any suggestions you may have to make this the best club in the Erie area. ## from the pro shop

### crane's tip

When playing fast greens and you have a long putt, your goal is to two-putt. First consider where you want to leave the ball for your second putt. Always try to leave an uphill putt with as little break as possible. Play extra break so when the ball dies it will be near the hole and not way past. For example: when you are on #11 and you are pin high, play an extra foot or two of break on your long putts and watch the ball roll down to the hole. Otherwise you may have a four or five footer uphill. The downside of this strategy is leaving the ball above the hole, which you never want to do.

### etiquette tip

Please THINK SAFETY when you are on the golf course. Do not ever hit when there is a chance you could hit into the group in

front of you. Always yell FORE and the hole number when others are in danger of a wayward shot. If you have ever been hit by a golf ball, you know it hurts and can lead to serious injury. In fact, several years ago, we had a player lose an eye due to being hit by a ball. So, for the safety of all, be courteous when you are playing golf.

### handicap tidbits

Scores that **MUST** be posted:

- An eighteen hole round when at least 13 holes are completed.
- All 9 hole rounds.
- Scores from both Match Play and Stroke Play Competitions
- Scores in team competitions, even when players are requested to pick up.
- Scores must be made in accordance with the principles of the Rules of Golf.
- Even when a player is disqualified from a competition, he/she must post a score.
