message from the president

The Board of Directors has been working very hard this year trying to give you the same quality golf course and services with less money to spend. We

have come to some decisions and hope you support our plans and policies. These are not easy decisions and require all the memberships' support. We have been saying in all our communications since the beginning of the year an assessment would be necessary if we did not reach our goal of 240 golf members. We are currently at 230 and the Board has no other alternative to balance our budget. Starting July 1st each golf member will be assessed \$80 per month for the next three months.

The equity committee has come up with a plan that the Board endorses and will be presenting to the entire membership at a special meeting July 22nd at 7:30 PM. The good news is that we have a plan that can secure our financial future for years to come. If approved and accepted by our membership we could actually credit this assessment back to you before year end and freeze your current dues for the next three years as long as membership stays at current levels. It's going to take a financial commitment by a portion of our membership and the approval of some changes to our By-Laws by the majority of our members. Those changes would be voted on at a separate meeting later in the year. The Board of Directors believes in this plan and we urge you to come and listen to the presentation at the special meeting on July 22nd.

ETIQUETTE TIP

Please **THINK SAFETY** when you are on the golf course. Do not ever hit when there is a chance you could hit into the group in front of you. Always yell **FORE** and the hole number when others are in danger of a wayward shot. If you have ever been hit by a golf ball, you know it hurts and can lead to serious injury.

HANDICAP TIDBITS

Scores that **MUST** be posted:

An eighteen hole round when at least 13 holes are completed.

All 9-hole rounds.

Scores from both Match Play and Stroke Play Competitions

Scores in team competitions, even when players are requested to pick up.

Scores must be made in accordance with the principles of the Rules of Golf.

Even when a player is disqualified from a competition, he must post a score.

CRANE'S TIP

For extra distance, try opening your back foot (right for Right handers) instead of your front foot.

RULES QUESTION

A player using the Blue Tees, plays his tee shot from the Black Tees. Is there a penalty?

ANSWER: If the Black tees are more than two club lengths behind the Blue Tees, the player has teed off from an area outside the permitted teeing area. The definition of teeing ground is a rectangular area two-club lengths in depth, the front and sides of which are defined by the outside limits of two tee-markers. In match play, there is no penalty. However, the opponent may require the player to cancel the stroke and play a ball from within the teeing ground. In stroke play, the player is assessed a two stroke penalty and he must correct his mistake by playing a ball within the teeing ground.
