election of directors

We would be remiss not to acknowledge the service of outgoing Board members Whitey Cleaver and Ron DiSantis, who opted not to seek reelection to the Board. Cleaver served three terms as Director and two years as Board President. DiSantis was a Board member for two three-year terms and served most recently as Membership Chairman. Their dedication to the Club and commitment to serve the membership is sincerely appreciated.

Thanks also to Mary Sue Longnecker for her willingness to stand for election to the Board, her interest in LVCC, and her willingness to serve the membership.

CRANE'S TIP

To improve your scoring, work on your short game. Practice your long putting to avoid those three and four putts. The key to being a good lag putter is distance control. Play extra break so that when your ball dies, it will not continue to roll past the hole. To be a good long putter you should hold the putter as lightly as possible to create good feel. Make a long, flowing stroke with a good follow through. You will find that it is much easier to control your distance this way rather than with a short, quick, "hit" stroke.

ETIQUETTE TIP

After play from a bunker, rake the sand as smooth as possible so the next player will have a fair lie, place the rake outside of the bunker, and please, stomp your feet or knock the sand off your shoes so you do not track the sand onto the green.

HANDICAP TIDBITS

A player's Handicap Index may be reduced when a player has a minimum of two eligible tournament score differentials that are at least 3.0 better than the player's calculated Handicap Index.

RULES QUESTION

At Lake View, A player has a 150 yard stake in his way but it does not affect his swing or stance. Is he entitled to relief?

ANSWER: No. At Lake View, if you look at the scorecard, 150 yard stakes are considered as immovable obstructions. Players receive relief for swing and stance only. The player cannot remove the stake because it is designated as fixed. Should he do so, he would be penalized two strokes for improving his line of play. You should check the rules at different courses as some may designated the markers as movable obstructions. In that case, the player can remove the stake.

JUNIOR LESSONS

Every Thursday morning beginning June 12 and continuing until July 24 (Tournament and Picnic). Assistant Professionals Joe Alonge and Adam Singer are the main teachers for this program. Classes are open to all children and grandchildren of Lake View Members. There are three classes. The 9:00 class is for children 13 and over. They will have a one hour lesson followed by nine holes of golf. The younger children will have just the one hour class. The 10:00 class is for children age 10-12. The 11:00 class for age 7-9. The lessons conclude with a tournament and picnic on July 19. The one-hour class includes instruction, rules, and contests.

Children should show up at the designated time. No pre-registration is required. The fee is \$25 per child. The concluding picnic is an additional \$5.

FAMILY DAY Sunday, June 8

Bring out the entire family for 9 holes of golf. Bring as many players as you like. As a way to keep play moving, tee times are every 15 minutes. You



have 15 minutes to complete each hole, then a horn will sound and you must proceed to the next hole. This guarantees your group and everyone else a 2 hour and 15 minute round. Special tees will be set up for beginners and the children. \$10 green fees for guests, children under 12 free. Carts are normal prices. Players wishing to continue onto the back 9 will be charged for carts only. Call now for your tee time.

MEN'S MEMBER-MEMBER

Saturday and Sunday, June 28 and 29

The competitive event of the year. Pick your own partner for this match play tournament. The field is split into flights of six teams based on total handicap. Each team will play a nine hole best ball match against every team in their flight. Teams receive one point for a tie, Two points for a win, three points if you win three up, or four points if your win by four or more holes. Total points from all matches determine the winners. Flight winners participate in a Shootout at the conclusion of the matches. There are two shootouts. In a shootout, the team with the highest score is eliminated on each hole. You will play 27 holes on Saturday and 18 on Sunday. Entry fee is \$35 per person (includes a Saturday lunch) plus \$25 for a cash pool.

There will be special flights for players using the white tees. All players will play from the same tees in a flight.
