## message from the president

Last month when I wrote this message I said it was snowing, today it is 70 degrees with lots of sunshine! What a difference a month makes. The golf course survived the winter months well and is in great shape for this time of year. We are still excited about this season and hope you take full advantage of your membership. You should have received by now the details of our new programs. We are trying to expand the member to member list and hope you consider adding your company's name, it's a great way to bring in more business and give your fellow member a discount.

The board has decided to relax its restrictions on tee times for members. On weekends a secondary member can play after 10:00 AM, on Wednesday 2:00 PM and on Tuesday mornings 10:00 AM. With the decreased membership our course just is not as busy as it once was. Restricted players will continue to play at restricted times as posted in the Chip Shots. A secondary member may now play after 10:00 AM on Saturday and Sunday, after 2:00 PM on Wednesday, and after 10:00 AM on Tuesday mornings.

We have also created a new membership incentive (four for the price of three) that we hope you will tell your friends about. If a foursome joins Lake View at the same time the cost for the balance of this year will be equal to that of three members. Each new member will be charged seventy five percent of initiation, dues and assessments for 2008. All fees for balance of year will be due upon approval of membership. We have extended the \$250 credit for members sponsoring new members so that could mean a \$1,000 credit to you. Less than four members can join at half the initiation fee (\$750) if they pay their fees upfront.

These are tough times for Lake View and your Board of Directors continues to try to create new ways to attract new members but it is up to you to bring them in the door. As I have said before, without increased membership, that only you can provide, we will be forced into another assessment. At the same time we are also working to bring more value to you; the existing member. Our goal is not only to survive but increase our membership and make Lake View the number one choice for golf in the Erie area.

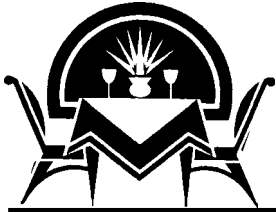

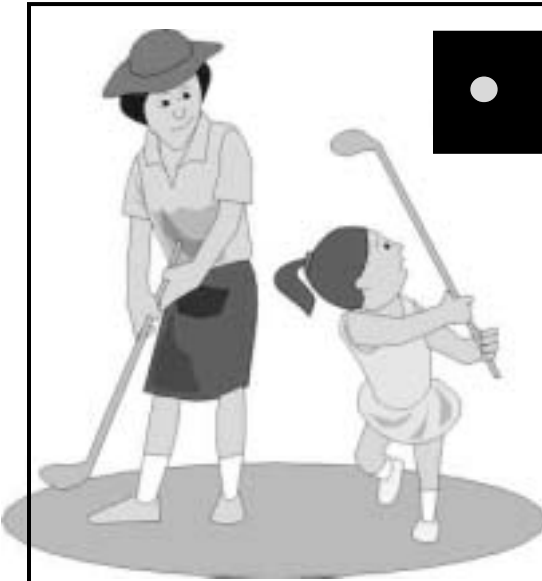

### ½ PRICE GREEN FEES ON MONDAYS

On May 5, & May 12, the club is running a special on Mondays where you can bring out guests at ½ price (\$27.50). Each member can invite up to seven guests. The member must play. Carts are regular price. The course opens at 12:00 on Mondays.

### RESTRICTED TEE TIMES

The golf committee and the board of directors decided to reduce the amount of restricted tee times to the following:

Tuesdays: Ladies only until 10:00,  
Men's League 4:00-6:00

Wednesdays: Men only 11:00-2:00

Weekends: Primary members  
until 10:00

Note: Restricted members paying reduced dues remain restricted until 11:00 on weekends.

### FOUR ROUND LIMIT

Under General Rules of Play in the Chip Shots, non golfing members and guests are limited to four rounds of golf during the season. The board of directors has instructed the pro shop to strictly enforce this rule for all social members and spouses of individual members. All rounds played between April 15 and October 15, with the exception of member-guests, scotch scrambles, and parent child events, will be counted against the four round maximum.

### NEW SENIOR DAY

On either Thursday or Friday of each week, there will be a senior event starting at 9:00 AM. Each week is a different tournament. Play when you want to, no weekly commitment. Pairings will be determined by draw. Event may be a two-man best ball, four-man team, southern point, yellow ball, etc. Friday, May 2 is our first event. Please sign up in the pro shop by Thursday at noon so we can draw the pairings. Harry West suggested to be eligible you must meet AARP requirements. Play will be from the white tees. Everyone chips in \$5 for prizes.

### LOOKING FOR A GAME

Twice a month we are bringing back the shoot-outs. Sign up to play beginning at 9:00. We will draw for pairings. Two man teams compete in a best ball format. \$20 entry includes \$10 for team best ball, \$5 gross skins, \$5 net. First two events are Saturday, May 10 and Sunday, May 25.

### 2008 RATES

The green fees for a guest playing with a member are \$55. Guests sponsored by a member have a green fee of \$75. Carts for members and their guests are \$16 per person.

### CART SPECIAL

Want to save \$48? Purchase 20 cart rides for the price of 17. You receive a punch card with 20 rides for you or your guests to use. The \$272 must be paid up front to get the savings.

### SOCIAL MEMBERS & NON-GOLFING MEMBERS

Have you been interested in playing golf but lack confidence, feel intimidated or are just unsure of how to go about taking advantage of the best golf course in the area? We're offering you the opportunity to enjoy this great game! Stress free lessons... no pressure... an introduction to the game! Assistant Golf Professionals Joe Alonge and Adam Singer offer clinics just for you. Classes are groups of four or less and consist of five lessons (including on course instruction). Fee is \$75 per person.

## RULES QUESTION

At the Masters, Tom Watson moved his ball marker so it would not be in the line of his fellow competitor. He did not move the marker back and putted from the wrong place. He missed. What happened?

**ANSWER:** Before hitting his next putt, Watson was alerted to the fact that he putted without moving his marker back. He received a two stroke penalty for playing from the wrong place. He was required to replace the ball on its original mark. He did so and made the putt. He therefore actually saved one stroke (still a double as his original putt was for a four) as strokes played from a wrong place are disregarded. Had the committee decided that Watson had gained a significant advantage by not replacing his ball and correcting his mistake, he could have been disqualified.

### TEE TIME SYSTEM

The tee time system begins Saturday, May 3. Weekday tee Times can be made one week in advance.

Weekend and holiday tee times are determined by the Lottery System.

- 1) Fill out a card in the pro shop listing the members of your foursome and the approximate time you would like to play. Cards may also be filled out by calling the pro shop, 725-9561, sending e-mail to lvccpro@choiceonemail.com, or click on e-mail Steve on the web-site.
- 2) Cards must be turned in by Wednesday at 10:00 AM
- 3) The pro shop will shuffle the cards and draw them one at a time. As each card is drawn, a tee time will be assigned to that group as close as possible to the requested time.
- 4) You can find your tee time by calling the pro shop or on the web-site, www.lakeviewcc.com.
- 5) Every foursome must fill out a card, if you need two tee times, you must have two cards.
- 6) Each foursome is allowed only one card.
- 7) Failure to show for your tee time, or failure to cancel within a reasonable amount of time, will result in your card being placed at the bottom of the pile the following week. You need not cancel due to bad weather conditions.
- 8) After the drawing is completed, calls will be accepted for the remaining tee times.

**CRANE'S TIP**

Check your alignment. Both your good and bad shots can be a result of whether or not you are lined up to your target. For example: If you have your feet and shoulders aimed to the right of your target, you will probably come over the top and pull the ball. Lay a club on the ground touching both toes after you take your set up. Walk behind the club and see if you are properly aligned. Concern yourself with five areas of alignment, feet, knees, hips, shoulders, and eyes.

**ETIQUETTE TIP**

Always allow faster players to play through when you have an open hole. There is nothing more frustrating than to play behind a group that is forcing you to wait on every shot when it is not necessary. Please, if you see that the group behind you is waiting, let them play through. A good time to do this is on a par 3 when you can wave them up while you are on the green. This rule should especially be followed when the course is not crowded.
