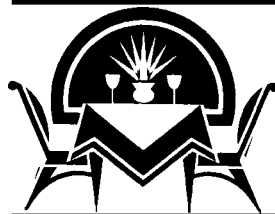

### posting off-season scores

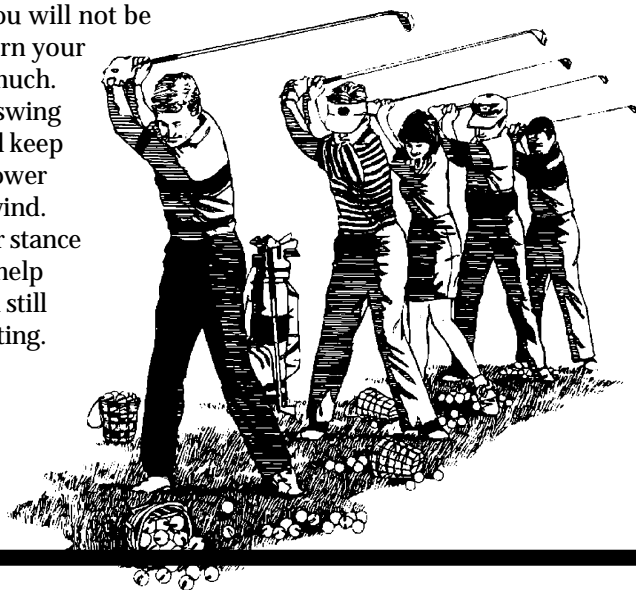
Although posting of scores has officially ended for the Erie area, rounds played at golf courses located in the south and west should still be posted. If the course you play is on the GHIN system, you should be able to post your score in their computer. You will need your GHIN number. Ghin #'s are available by printing a label at the pro shop computer or call us. Another option is to post over the internet. Go to [www.ghin.com](http://www.ghin.com) and click on post on line.

### november hours

The pro shop will be open on days when the weather is nice enough to rent carts. The hours of operation will be weekdays, 9:00 – 1:00, weekends 8:00-2:00. All guests will be required to pay a \$27.50 green fee. If there is no one in the pro shop, the fee must be paid in the office. If you are concerned whether the pro shop will be open or not, call the pro shop 725-9561, the office 725-9644, or Steve at home 899-8417.

### crane's tip of the month

When the wind is blowing, widen your stance. This gives you better stability and the wind will have less effect. Use more club as you will not be able to turn your body as much. A slower swing speed will keep the ball lower into the wind. The wider stance also will help you stand still while putting.



## MEMBERSHIP NOTES

### new member recruitment

At the October board meeting the board approved a new program aimed at recruiting new members who are currently members of other private country clubs. Effective immediately, any current member of another country club that is approved for membership at Lake View will enjoy our membership privileges for the remainder of 2007 and all of 2008 by paying for ten (10) months of 2008. No payment is due until March 2008 at which time the new member has the option of paying all dues and assessments for the year 2008 (prorated for 10 months of 2008) or they may pay half of the dues and assessments in March and the remaining half in June 2008. This program allows the new member to enjoy the facilities and holiday events of Lake View and maybe even a few rounds of golf if the weather allows. Current members are encouraged to make this program known to acquaintances who are members at other country clubs and looking for a change to the best golf course in the area. For further information, contact the business office.

### step down provisions

Current members considering a transfer in membership classification are reminded of the provisions of Bylaw II, Section 3D, Paragraph g.

A member may transfer from a voting membership (golf) to a non-voting membership (social) only once. This is commonly called a 'step down'. That member may transfer back to a voting membership only once as approved by a vote of the Board of Directors. If this action takes place within a 12 month period, the member must pay all membership dues, minimums, and assessments accrued between the time of the 'step down' and the date of reapplication approval.

Should the member remain in the non-voting (social) membership category in excess of 12 months there would be no repayment required to rejoin as a voting member (golf).

A member who resigns from the club and wishes to rejoin at a later date would be considered as a new applicant for membership (Bylaw II, Section 3) and subject to the application fees in effect at the time of application and approval of the Board of Directors Membership Committee.

Exceptions to these policies may be considered due to extenuating circumstances (e.g. injury, illness, job transfer, etc.) and are subject to the approval of the Board of Directors.

## RULES QUESTION

A player's tee shot on #10 plugs in the rough. All players agree the ball has plugged. After searching 5 minutes, he cannot find his ball. The embedded ball rule is in effect through the green. Does the player have to declare his ball lost and return to the tee?

**ANSWER:** Yes, unless the ball is lost in an abnormal ground condition such as casual water or ground under repair the ball is considered lost and the player must return to the tee under the lost ball rule.

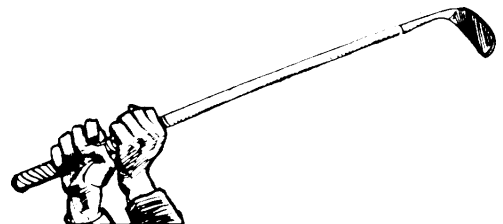


