## message from the president

I am going to use this message this month to give you some answers to questions asked of me recently. If you have a question or concern please contact myself or any board member. We will try to keep you as informed as possible. Here are some of the questions I have received.

"I would like to see a financial statement. Can you give me one or post in the locker room?" We cannot post because of the nature of the information that would be available to all guests and outside groups that use our golf and dining facilities. However, all members can stop by the office during the day and ask Cindy to look at the statements. It's your club and you have every right to review that information.

"How are we doing financially?" Membership numbers have been low all year and that's why we were forced to ask for the special assessment. Provided we do not see any further decrease in membership, we will cover

If their company does not make this work we will be forced to take the operation back and our history of profit in dining is not good.

"Why should the members who do not play in the three-day pay for the expenses of the event?" All participants in this event pay a fee to play which includes all expenses for both the pro shop and the dining room; these expenses include prizes, carts, green fees, food, entertainment, decorations, and fireworks. No expenses are taken from our budget.

"How is the perpetual membership idea going?" It is more than an idea, we have opened a special escrow account and we are currently collecting deposits. This is the answer to our financial security and I hope more of you take advantage of this great offer and participate.

Congratulations to Ellery Tarbell, city champ. We are all proud to have Lake View represented so well and to say he belongs to our club.

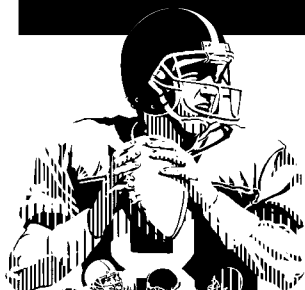

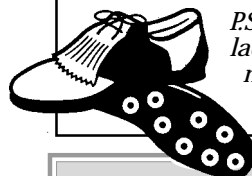

## RULES QUESTION

A 150 stake is in my way but does not affect my swing or stance. Do I get relief? Can I pull the stake out?

**ANSWER:** No. At Lake View, 150 yard stakes are considered immovable obstructions. A player may take relief if the stake interferes with a player's swing or stance but there is no relief for intended line of play. The player cannot remove the stake (even if he can) because the stake is designated as an immovable obstruction. The player is in violation of rule 13-2 (improving your lie) by removing the stake. Penalty- loss of hole in match play, two strokes in stroke play.

## from the pro shop

### CRANE'S TIP

Need more distance! A way to get more distance off the tee is to shallow out your swing and hit the ball on the "up" swing. Backspin is created by hitting "down" on the ball. The less backspin you have, the farther the ball goes. Tee the ball up, have the lowest (shallowest) part of your swing occur before impact and you will see good results.

### ETIQUETTE TIP

Players using pull carts need to obey pull cart signage and golf etiquette. Players with pull carts and electric walking carts need to walk around greenside bunkers and NOT between the bunkers and the green. The reason for this rule is wear and tear on your golf course. If every walker used this same path over and over, it kills the grass. The result is bare spots to chip out of.
