RULES QUESTION

What actions are permissible on the putting green that are normally not allowed off the putting green?

ANSWER: A) A ball on the putting green may be lifted and cleaned. The spot must be marked before it is lifted and the ball must be replaced on its original spot.

B) Improvements on the green: 1) Sand and loose soil on the putting green (but not anywhere else on the course) may be removed without penalty. 2) A player may repair damage on the putting green without penalty by taking reasonable actions to restore the putting green as nearly as possible to its original condition, but only: by using his or her hand, foot, or other body part or a normal ball-mark repair tool, tee, or similar item of normal equipment.

Damage on the putting green means damage caused by a person or outside influence such as: 1) ball marks, shoe damage (such as spike marks), and scrapes or indentations caused by equipment or the flagstick, 2) old hole plugs, turf plugs, seams of cut turf scrapes or indentations from maintenance tools or vehicles, 3) Animal tracks or hoof indentations, 4) embedded objects such as a stone, acorn, or tee.

MOST IMPROVED

The GHIN System ranks players based on a formula that assumes it is more difficult for a low handicap player to improve a larger number of strokes than it is for a higher handicap player. The USGA recommends the following formula: Add 12 to the player's index at the start of the season (value A). Add 12 to the player's index at the end of the season (value B). Divide value A by value B. Calculate to three decimal points. This is the improvement factor. The player with the highest improvement factor is the most improved. Based on the GHIN Formula, the rankings are as follows:

Handicap indexes are for April 1, 2022 to November 15, 2022

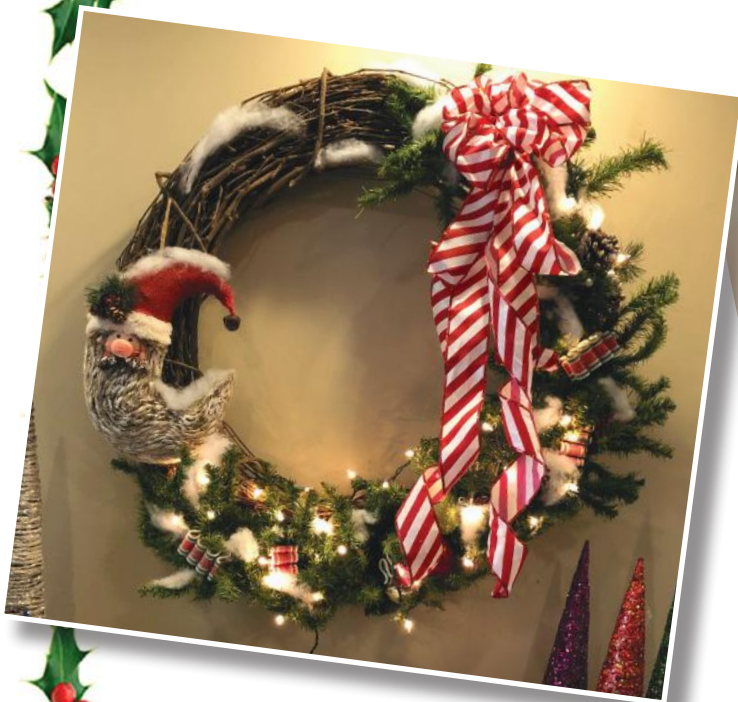
